

Georg Wittich - Member of the Board



Georg Wittich has extensive regulatory experience with financial markets, in particular from a European perspective. He established the Bundesaufsichtsamt für den Wertpapierhandel (Federal Securities Supervisory Office) in Frankfurt and served as its President from 1994 to 2002.

In 1998, Mr Wittich was elected Chairman of the Forum of European Securities Commissions which played a key role in developing common standards for European capital markets. In the International Organisation of Securities Commissions, Mr Wittich was Vice-Chair of the Technical Committee and Chairman of the Internet Project Team.

Prior to this, Mr Wittich held various senior posts in the Federal Ministry of Finance in Germany in the area of international finance and securities markets and he was Financial Counsellor at the German Embassy in Tokyo (1983 to 1987).

Mr Wittich graduated with law degrees from the University of Kiel and undertook additional studies at the Ecole Nationale d' Administration in Paris.
