Lord Currie of Marylebone has wide ranging experience in financial services, public administration and the education sector. In addition to serving on the Board of the DFSA, he is Chairman of the International Centre for Financial Regulation and of Semperian Investment Partners. He is also a Board Member of the Royal Mail, BDO UK, IG Group and the London Philharmonic Orchestra. He was the founding Chairman of Ofcom, the converged UK regulator for electronic communications from 2002 to 2009, and Dean of City University's Cass Business School in the City of London from 2001 to 2007.

Formerly he was Deputy Dean at the London Business School and a non-Executive Director of the Abbey National, as well as serving on the Board of the Office of Gas and Electricity Markets, the UK energy regulator, and a variety of other government bodies.

His academic research has been in the area of regulation. In his earlier career he worked in financial services, business, public administration and education.
