

Robert L Clarke - Member of the Board



Robert L Clarke has extensive experience with banking laws and regulations and bank supervision, both in the US and internationally. Mr Clarke founded the Financial Services Group at Bracewell & Giuliani, LLP in 1973. He was appointed by President Ronald Reagan as US Comptroller of the Currency and at the end of his first term was re-appointed by President George H W Bush. He served as Comptroller from 1985 to 1992 and during his tenure the agency supervised about 5,000 nationally chartered commercial banks. During that time he also served as a Member of the Board of Directors of the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation. In March 1992 he re-joined Bracewell & Giuliani LLP as Senior Partner and head of its financial services practice. Mr Clarke has served as a consultant and advisor to a number of countries on their bank supervisory operations.

Mr Clarke has an LLB from Harvard Law School and a Bachelor of Economics from Rice University.
